











Green Tunnel contractor change

Align JV, the construction contractor for the Chiltern Tunnel and the Colne Valley viaduct, says that it will be taking over from EKFB as the contractor for the Wendover Green Tunnel later this year. This was mentioned in the trade press last year and confirmed Align JV in a recent webinar about its progress with the Chiltern Tunnel.

Just before Christmas, Align said it was 90% of the way through the 10 mile (16km) Chiltern Tunnel which it started boring in 2021, and expects to break through at the northern end during 2024.

Two other significant developments planned for January include the initial realignment of the A413 to move it away from the Chiltern Railway line to allow piling for two viaduct pier foundations for the Small Dean Viaduct, north of the current Wendover Dean Viaduct. There will still be night-time road closures following the diversion. The other very visible work is the completion of the first pier, closest to Rocky Lane. The short vertical section was completed in December and the 50 ton precast

"hammerhead" is due for delivery and installation by the time you read this. These concrete structures will support the girders underneath the viaduct deck. A further five piers are expected to be completed during 2024

Ellesborough Road cutting excavation

Further excavation for the Green Tunnel cutting beside Ellesborough Road continued in January, and another bridge is planned here to carry the Thames Water main and sewage pipes. Crash barriers and road signs have now been installed on the diversion road which will allow excavation through Ellesborough Road to be started.
